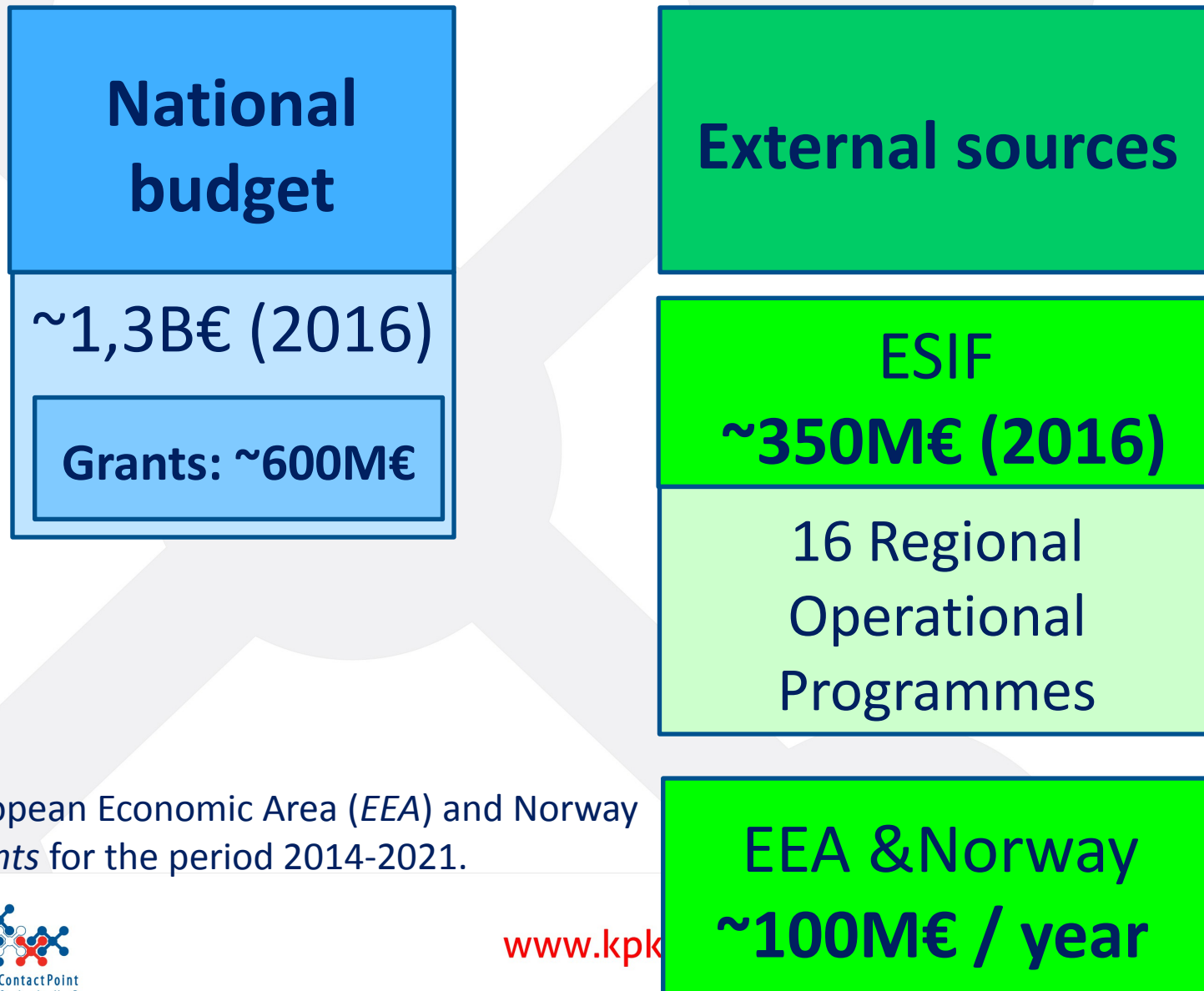

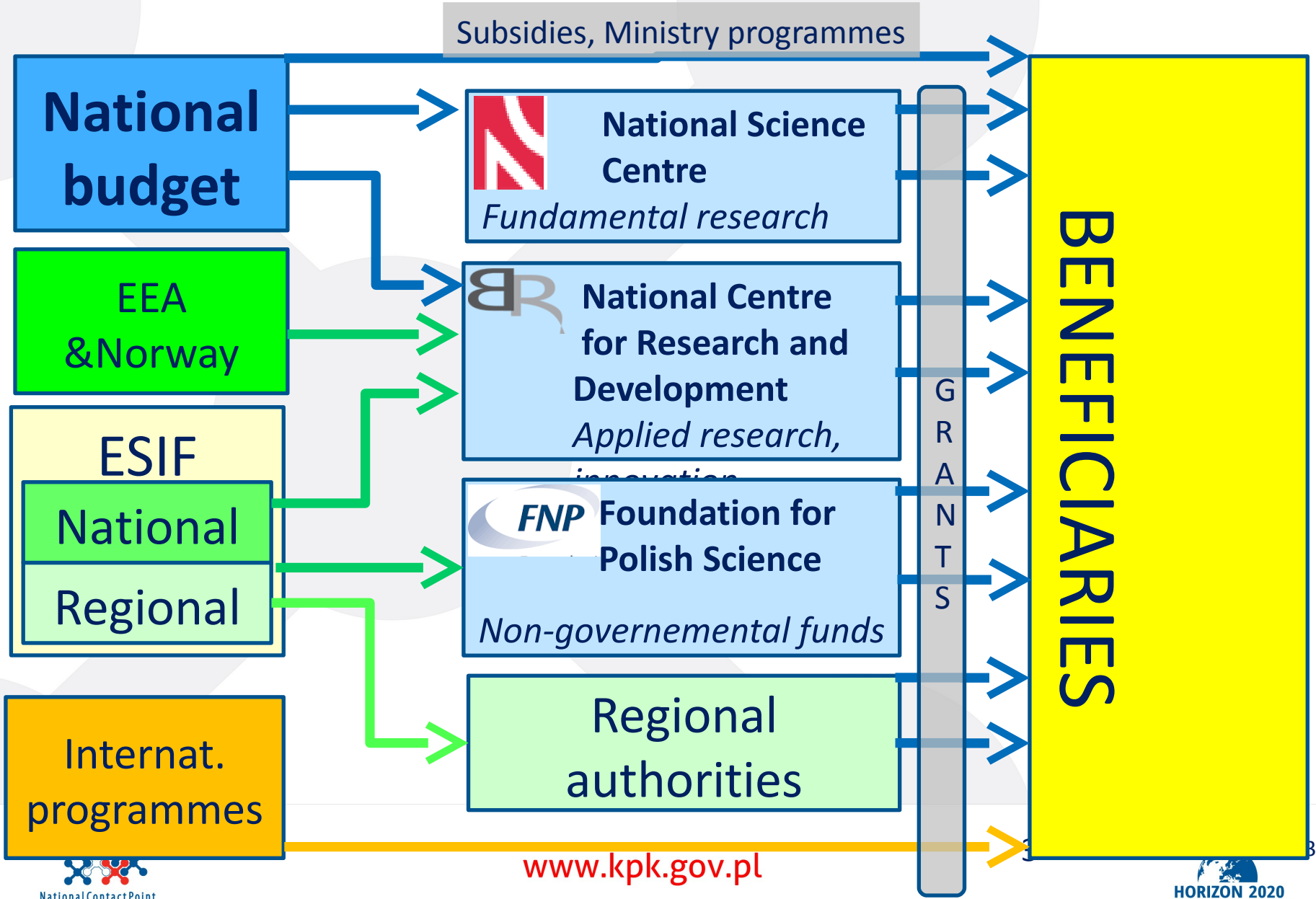

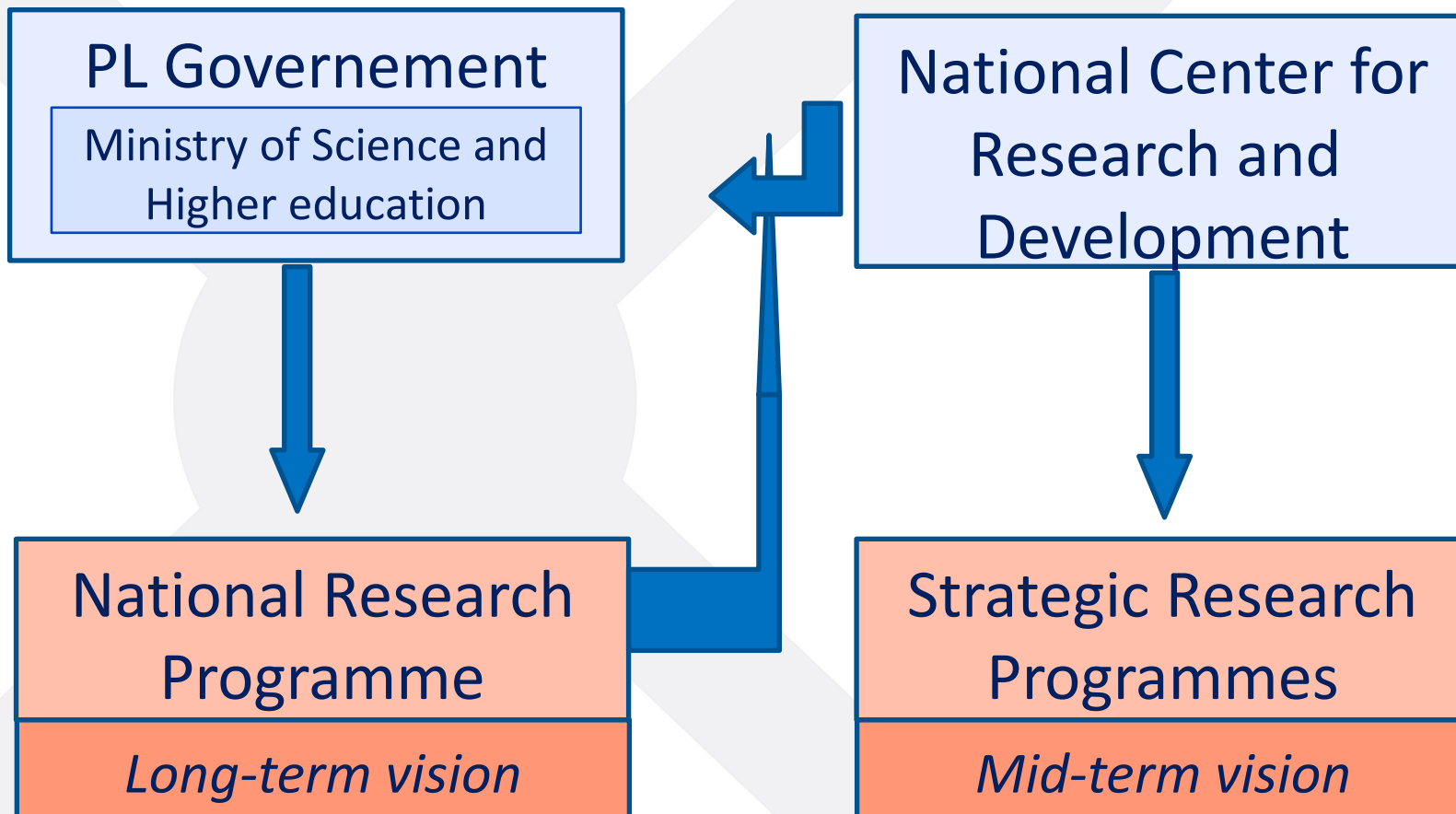
European Economic Area (EEA) and Norway Grants for the period 2014-2021.

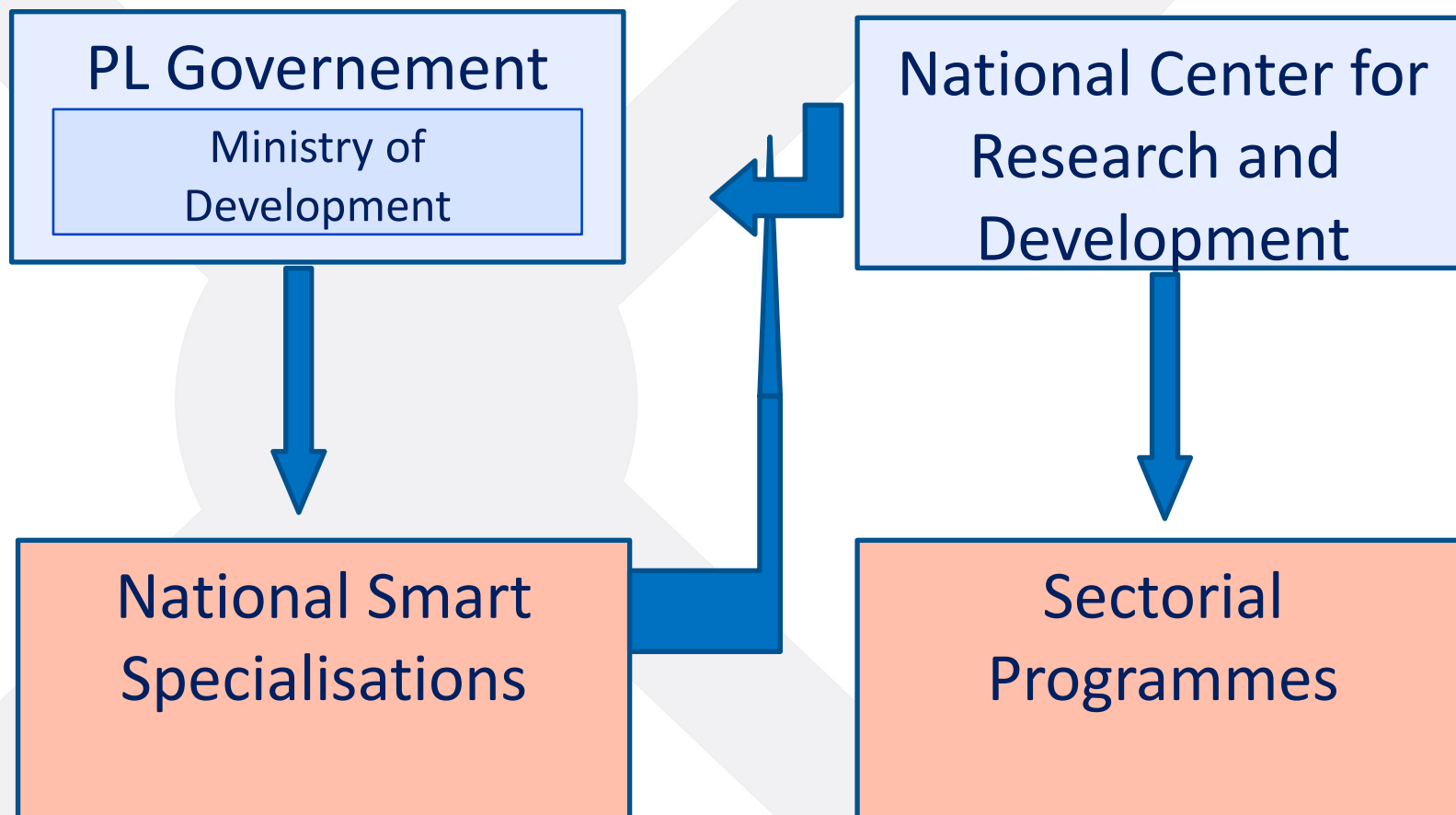

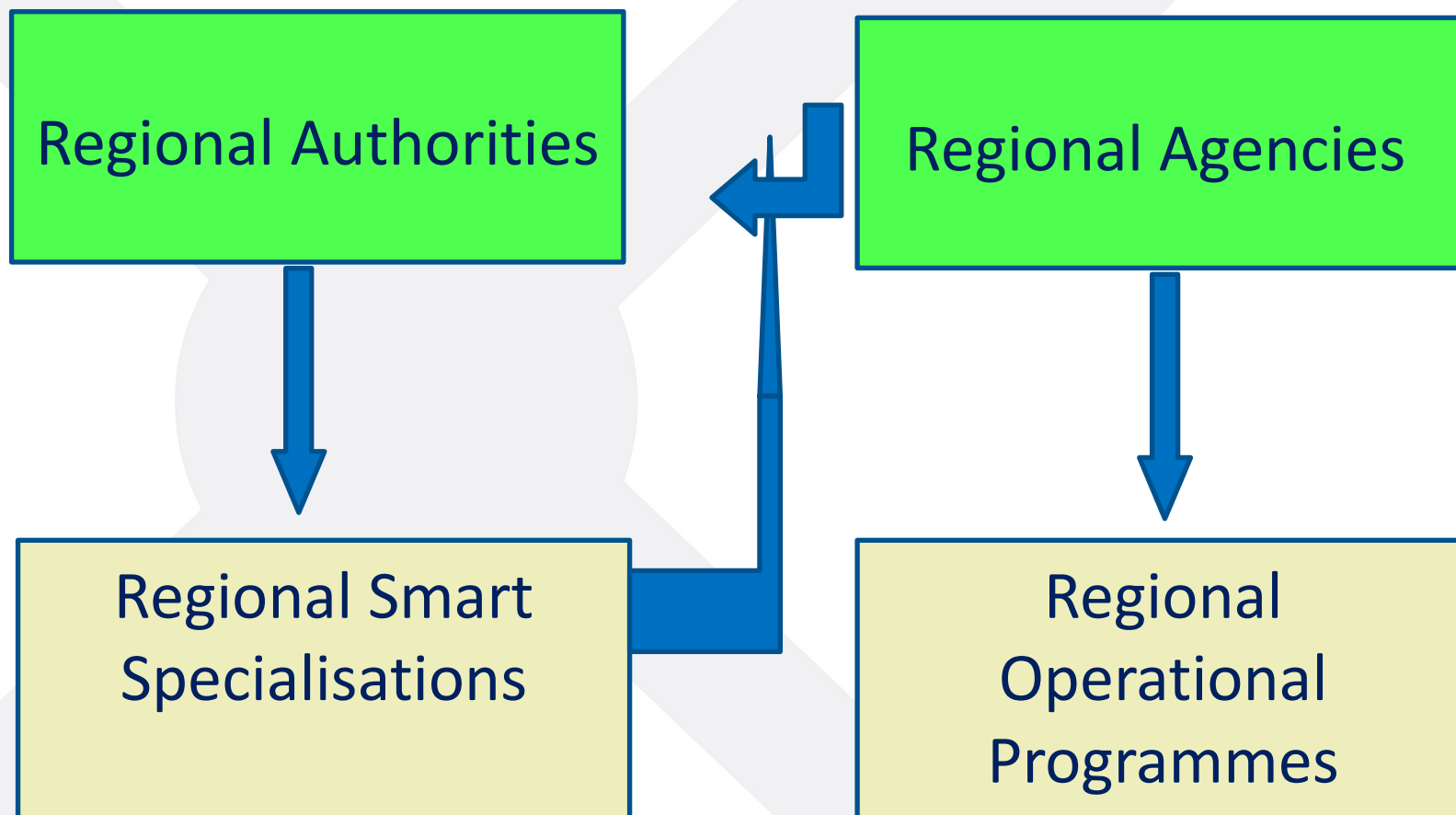
Strategy for research in Poland – national budget

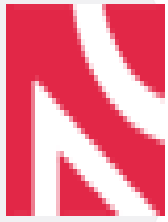


Strategy for research in Poland – Structural Funds

National Science Centre

Government agency set up in 2011 to support basic research in Poland

Budget: over € 200 M a year

Funds projects in three areas

- Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences,
- Life Sciences
- Physical Sciences and Engineering

11 types of funding schemes dedicated to researchers at different stages of scientists career.

Foundation realizes its statutory purposes through:

- **Modernization of research facilities**
- **Assisting innovative ventures and commercialization of scientific discoveries and inventions.**
- **Budget: ~20M€ / year (own funds (4M€) + ESIF)**
