
16 Regional Operational Programmes

European Economic Area (*EEA*) and Norway *Grants* for the period 2014-2021.




EEA &Norway ~100M€ / year





Strategy for research in Poland – national budget










Strategy for research in Poland – Structural Funds



National Science Centre

Government agency set up in 2011 to support basic research in Poland

Budget: over € 200 M a year

Funds projects in three areas

- Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences,
- Life Sciences
- Physical Sciences and Engineering

11 types of funding schemes dedicated to researchers at different stages of scientists career.









Foundation for Polish Science

in operation since 1991

non-governmental, non-political, non-profit institution which pursues the mission of supporting science.

Foundation realizes its statutory purposes through:

- Support for distinguished scholars and research teams in all fields of inquiry
- Modernization of research facilities
- Assisting innovative ventures and commercialization of scientific discoveries and inventions.
 - Budget: ~20M€ / year (own funds (4M€) + ESIF)









National Centre for Research and Development

- appointed in the summer 2007
- implementing agency of the Minister of Science and Higher Education.
- support to applied research and innovation
- Budget (2016): ~290M€ from national budget~349M€ from ESIF
