# IncoNet EaP / EaP PLUS: multi-level support actions

- 3 year long Coordination & Support Actions dedicated to the EU –
   EaP STI cooperation
- Predecessor: IncoNet EaP (2013-2016)
- Successor: EaP PLUS (2016-2019)
- Build on previous FP7 and other projects addressing the region (Bilat, BS-Eranet, BSH, etc.)
- Both consortia include partners from <u>all</u> the 6 EaP countries and from several EU MS





# IncoNet EaP / EaP PLUS: multi-level support actions

### Three main objectives:

- Support to EU-EaP Policy Dialogue
- II. Foster interaction between EU-EaP researchers & promotion of H2020
- III. Enhance the EU-EaP research-innovation partnership





#### I. Support to EU-EaP Policy Dialogue

- ✓ Tailor-made support to the EaP Panel on R&I since 2013 (next meeting: 14 Dec. 2016)
- Maximizing the Impact of Association to H2020 (e.g. Association Conferences in each EaP A/C; Workshop for EaP Programme Committee Members, etc.)
- ✓ Supporting dialogue through Policy Stakeholders Conferences (Yerevan/May 2014 on CC; Minsk/May 2015 on EN; Budapest/Apr. 2016 on HE, etc.)
- ✓ STI Policy Mix Peer Reviews as a tool for R&I reforms (Georgia 2015; Armenia 2015)





## II. Interaction between EU-EaP researchers & promotion of H2020

- ✓ Support EaP funding agencies to participate in ERANETs/JPIs (consultation process, Workshop Baku Oct. 2016)
- ✓ Grants for Twinning among Research Institutes/Teams (to facilitate contacts in view of proposals to H2020)
- ✓ Small Grants for EaP researchers to attend Brokerage Events in EU
- ✓Info Days and Support to H2020 NCP Networks in all EaP Countries (training, awareness campaigns for NCPs)





## II. Interaction between EU-EaP researchers & promotion of H2020

- ✓ Identification of EaP researchers through Mapping Exercises and Co-publication Analyses (focus on Energy, Climate Change and Health)
- ✓ Support targeted cooperation with EaP Scientific Diaspora (organization of conferences/workshops)
- ✓ Establishment of a regional STI Evaluation Network leading to a MoU (with the participation of all the EaP countries)





#### III. Enhance the EU-EaP research-innovation partnership

- ✓ Promoting ETPs/JTIs/EIT & EEN in EaP (linking European platforms with similar EaP structures)
- ✓Implementation of a Grant Scheme to boost EU-EaP Cluster collaboration
- √ Trainings for technology managers & policymakers
- **✓ Co-patenting analysis focusing on international patents**
- ✓ Presenting benefits of the Innovation Union Scoreboard
