



from 1984 to 2020





- Q. How do I update the information related to my organisation once I have obtained a Participant Identification Code (PIC)?
- A. Before the organisation is validated (i.e. still in the status "declared"): the data entered during first registration remain editable for the person having registered the organisat...
- I am the Legal Entity Appointed Representative (LEAR) of my organisation and have made an update in the beneficiary register some days ago, but it seems that nothing has been updated.
- A. Your request to change information is being processed by the Validation Services (VS). Modifications of legal information (e.g. legal name, address, VAT number, registration number,...
- I have sent the Legal Entity Appointed Representative (LEAR) appointment documents.

 Q. When may I receive access to modify the data on the beneficiary register of the Participant Portal?
- A. It may take a few weeks before the appointed LEAR is validated. First the legal entity needs to be validated by the Validation Services. You will receive a confirmation e-mail explai...
- Q. I have an ECAS account for accessing the Participant Portal but how can I acquire roles and access rights for proposals, projects or organisations?
- A. As a general principle, the user who has created the content on the Participant Portal manages access to this content by other users. In other words, there is no centrally controlled...
- Q. How can I change my email address or correct spelling errors in my name in my ECAS account?
- A. When you are logged in in the Participant Portal, click on the button with your user name (top-right corner), choose "My Account", then "Modify my personal data". Users having a Legal...
- Q. What happens if my organisation registered twice (and has two Participant Identification Codes (PICs)) in the Participant Portal?
- A. If you discover a duplicate registration of the organisation (the same organisation has been registered twice), please ask your Legal Entity Appointed Representative (LEAR) to contac...

NCPs tasks



- Guidance on choosing relevant H2020 topics and types of action;
- Help to improve the performance of their country in MSCA;
- Disseminate the information about the calls;
- Organise info-days in universities, research organisations and other stakeholders;
- Advice on administrative procedures and contractual issues;
- Training and assistance on proposal writing;
- Distribution of documentation (forms, guidelines, manuals etc.);
- Assistance in partner search;
- Answer questions of the potential applicants and if this is difficult contact the Commission or REA to find the answer;
- Follow the evolution of the participation of their country;
- In case of more than one NCPs and or more than one host organisations for NCPs: coordinate their efforts, work together;

What is the NCP network?

NCPs are national structures established and financed by governments of the 28 EU member states and the states associated to the framework programme. NCPs give personalised support on the spot and in applicants' own languages. The NCP systems can vary from one country to another from highly centralised to decentralised networks, and a number of very different actors, from ministries to universities, research centres and special agencies to private consulting companies.



In possession of a doctoral degree, or have 4 years of full-time research experience at the time of the call deadline

 Apply in conjunction with a host institution in EU or AC that will manage the grant

For fellows coming to or moving within Europe (12-24 months)

Any Experienced Researcher may submit only one proposal to the call for proposals in any given year

For fellows from Europe going to Third countries (12-24 months) and returning (12 months)



Georgian fellows grouped by the country of destination (top countries):



Staff going to Georgia, grouped by country of sending organisation (top countries):





Statistics for FP7 and H2020

Our organization (ICARTI) was participated in 3 projects in FP7 framework programme.

Now it is involved in 4 ongoing projects.

In 2015 Georgia took part as a partner in 10 projects of RISE programme. The results is not known so far.


We do not have official information for 2016. But best of my knowledge, Georgia is involved as a partner at least one RISE project.

One must note that the same group was participated in FP7 (IRSES) project together with other 6 countries (coordinator was Hungary) in 2011-2015; Budget of 0.35 M€. 12 Georgian scientists were involved in the project. Over 20 scientists have visited Georgian Institutions.
